LAKE STEWARD REPORT

Winter ice cover is the only up-to-date statistic to report. The lake froze over on December 22, 2023 and the ice was gone on April 4, 2024. Ice coverage was 103 days, the <u>shortest period in two decades</u>. The running average over those years is 130 days.

2023 water chemistry results should be available for the AGM.

Friends of the Muskoka Watershed (https://fotmw.org/) held a webinar this winter Titled: Understanding and Responding to the Threat of Road Salt in Muskoka Lakes. The speaker was Dr. Neil Hutchinson. He classed environmental concerns into three groups:

- 1. Improving: acid rain, lead pollution, DDT, phosphorous.
- 2. Uncertain but worrisome: mercury, pharmaceuticals, biocides, micro and nano plastics.
- 3. Worsening: invading species, climate change, algal blooms, calcium decline and salt.

Regarding salt, it is estimated that for every permanent Muskoka resident, a tonne of salt is spread on area roads and parking lots.

You may have noticed that the Hobo lake level/temperature gauge has been off-line for several months. The unit has been replaced, this is the new link:
